

Friday Harbor Travel Information

For programs aboard the schooner *Adventuress*

Please plan to arrive at the ship no later than the start time on the date of your trip.

It is possible to fly to Seattle and travel to the ship all on the same day, but connections can be tricky. Some participants choose to stay in Seattle, Anacortes or Friday Harbor the night before their trip.

We recommend that you fly into Seattle early that day or the night before. Take the Airporter Super Shuttle or Gray Line of Seattle bus to Anacortes. Walk onto the San Juan Ferry in Anacortes then walk to the ship in the Friday Harbor Marina.

Approximate Travel Times:

SeaTac Airport to Seattle ----- 30 minutes
Seattle to Anacortes ----- 2 hour drive
Anacortes Ferry to San Juan Island ----- 1.5 hour boat ride
Ferry Terminal to Marina ----- 10 minute walk

Getting There

Without a car: recommended

SeaTac Airport to Anacortes: Take the **Airporter Super Shuttle** from SeaTac Airport directly to the Anacortes Ferry Terminal. It takes approximately three hours. For reservations and information, contact **Airporter Super Shuttle**.

Anacortes to San Juan Island: You may walk on to the ferry with your luggage. Ferry schedules change. Contact **Washington State Ferries** for current ferry schedule.

With a car:

SeaTac Airport to Anacortes: Take Interstate 5 North from Seattle to State Route 20. The exit is labeled for Anacortes and the San Juan Islands. Take Route 20 West (left) and follow signs to Anacortes. Do NOT follow signs to Port Townsend Ferry. Follow signs to the **San Juan Island Ferry** through Anacortes to the ferry terminal. It takes approximately 2.5 hours. Delays are possible during peak travel times. For current ferry schedule and fees contact **Washington State Ferries**.

You may take your car or walk with your luggage onto the ferry. There is free short-term parking in Anacortes. There is long-term parking available at the Anacortes Ferry Terminal for a fee. Contact the **Anacortes Chamber of Commerce** for more information.

By Float Plane:

SeaTac Airport to Seattle Lake Union: There are float planes available from downtown Seattle directly to Friday Harbor Marina. Take the **Airporter Super Shuttle** from SeaTac to the **Kenmore Air** Terminal on Lake Union.

Seattle Lake Union to Friday Harbor: Daily flights from Lake Union are available from **Kenmore Air**. For reservations and information contact **Kenmore Air**.

By Victoria Clipper:

SeaTac Airport to Seattle Waterfront: There is another faster and more costly alternative. **The Victoria Clipper** makes daily trips from Seattle to Victoria B.C., Canada with stops in Friday Harbor. Take the **Airporter Super Shuttle** from SeaTac to the **Victoria Clipper** Terminal in Seattle. For reservations and information, contact **Airporter Super Shuttle**.

Seattle to Friday Harbor: **The Victoria Clipper** departs daily from downtown Seattle to the San Juan Islands. For more information and reservations contact **The Victoria Clipper**.

Though foot passengers have never had to wait to board the ferry, waiting with your car during peak times is common. Recent changes have made this island the easiest of the San Juans for foot passengers to visit.

Now when the ferry docks at Friday Harbor, visitors are mere steps not only from restaurants and stores in the Cannery Landing complex, the schooner *Adventuress* and whale and historical museums, but also from a stylish new inn and several new B&B's. And a new bus service provides car-less visitors with another way around.

Friday Harbor, the San Juan Islands' largest and only incorporated town, is an east-facing village offering spectacular sunrise views and a day-long panorama of ferry and other boat activity. **Lodging reservations are essential.**
