

Bainbridge Island

Distances

Seattle: 6 miles west across Puget Sound by ferry

Portland: 190 miles north, crossing Tacoma Narrows Bridge and taking Hwy 16 through Bremerton to Poulsbo, then Hwy 305 to Bainbridge

Walking

1. From Bainbridge Ferry Terminal, walk through terminal and up the hill, alongside cars exiting the ferry.
2. Cross busy street after ferry toll booths and take first left side street, down towards the ferry maintenance facility.
3. Find the paved path going right from this side street, cross the bridge to the park, then walk west toward the waterfront. City Dock and *Adventuress* will be visible from here.

Driving (There is limited parking at this facility- ask Captain where to park. Be prepared to provide vehicle make and license plate number)

From ferry

1. Drive off ferry, keep to left lane.
2. Take a left at first stop light onto Winslow Way.
3. Take first left onto Bjune Drive.
4. Park in temporary space to unload gear.

From Olympic Peninsula

1. Take Hwy 305 south on Bainbridge to Winslow Way.
2. Turn right onto Winslow Way.
3. Take first left onto Bjune Drive.
4. Park in temporary space to unload gear.
