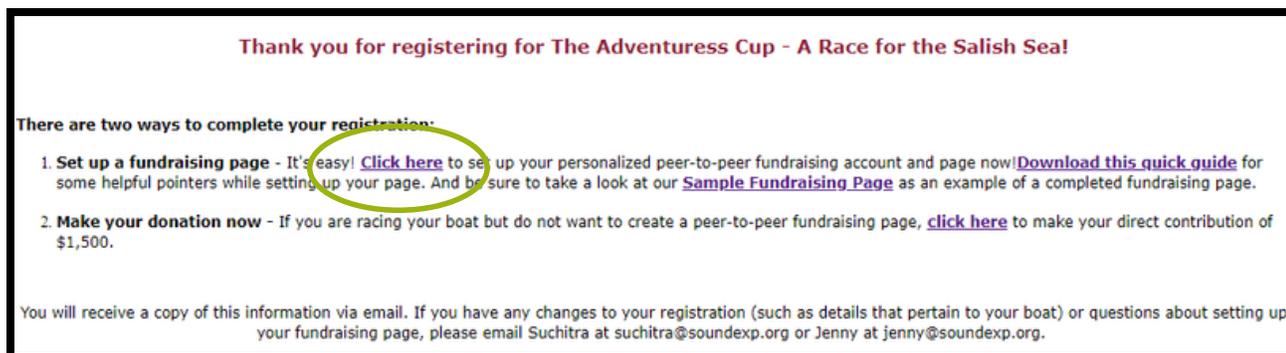


## How Do I Set Up My Personal Fundraiser Page? Quick guide for fundraisers

Once you've registered and received your confirmation email, follow these easy instructions to set up your Adventuress Cup Fundraising Page:

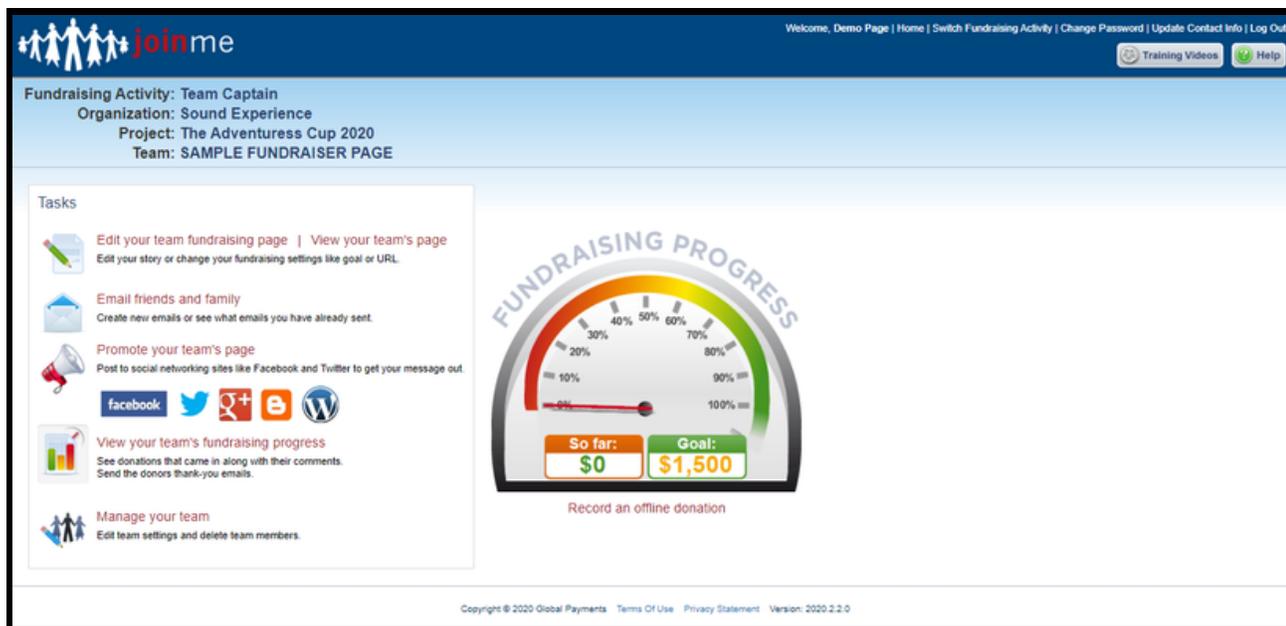
**1** In your registration confirmation email, click the link as shown in the green circle below.



**2** Create your peer-to-peer fundraising page on the online platform "Join Me" by clicking the "Click here to join!" link. Once you click the link you'll be prompted to create an account using your email address.

**3** Once you've created your account you'll be taken to your fundraising dashboard. From your dashboard you can:

- Choose a name for your campaign, boat and/or team
- Edit your fundraising page to include personalized text and photo/video
- Send email appeals to friends and family
- Post your page on social media profiles
- Manage your team (if you choose to have team members)
- View and track your fundraising progress, record offline donations and send thank you messages to those that have donated to your campaign



**4** Now it's time to personalize your page! Below are screenshots of the edit mode with tips to help make your page a hit and your fundraising effort successful.

Over the last few years I've learned that feeling connected to place is really important to me. Sailing aboard *Adventuress* helps keep me connected to the Salish Sea and I am really thankful that I am able to have that place-base connection for my job.  
I first stepped aboard *Adventuress* when I was 12 years old for a 4-day, 3-night overnight Girl Scout trip. I can honestly say it helped shaped me into the person I am today. I was so excited to be able to experience everything on board (although at first, I really struggled with anchor watch and the vegetarian food) and after the trip, brought up my experience in any conversation that I could fit *Adventuress* into. Fast forward 12 years and I was able to be crew for 2 sailing seasons as the Program Coordinator on board and I was able to help bring that same joy, curiosity and energy that I had as a kid to brand new young people. And now, as the Development & Education Coordinator on staff, I'm continuing to help make sure that impact continues.

Please keep in mind that those racing physical boats are encouraged to make a good faith commitment to raise a minimum of \$1,500 between July 6 and September 20, 2020. Virtual participants do not have a fundraising minimum but are encouraged to set their own fundraising goal.

If you don't want to reveal your page until it's complete, you can change this status to be "unpublished". In unpublished mode your page will only be visible on your account and will not appear on the Fundraising Directory.

Click "Done" to go back to your Dashboard or click "View" to show how your page will appear publicly. **NOTE:** Your story and photo/video section will be shown above the Sound Experience description and photo on your page. They are reversed here in the edit section.

On "View" portion of your page, you'll notice the **"Join as member"** link below your story text. This is a way for people to join your campaign as team members and they will then be part of your peer-to-peer fundraising model. This means that they should ask their friends and family to donate to your team page. Although each page for The Adventuress Cup is considered a "team" page, you do not need to have team members if you don't want to. There is an option when you first start your page to require a special code to allow folks to be part of your team. If you don't pick a code, anyone can join, if you do pick a code, you can invite folks to join as team members and give them your specific code to allow them to join.
